MMC GROUP ALLOCATES MORE THAN RM670,000 FOR LOCAL COMMUNITIES

Pontian, 19 June 2017 – MMC Corporation Berhad (“MMC” or “MMC Group”), a premier utilities and infrastructure group, today donated four Muslim hearses to four selected mosques around Johor as part of its zakat (alms) hand-outs to help facilitate Muslim funeral matters as well as for general usage of surrounding communities.

The Hiace Toyota vehicles, worth more than RM 670,000 were handed over by Johor State Executive Council for Public Works, Rural and Regional Development, YB Datuk Ir. Haji Hasni Bin Haji Mohammad to selected mosques’ representatives during a handover ceremony and break of fast event with local community at Masjid Jamek Temenggong Daeng Abd Rahman, Benut.

The four selected mosques were Masjid Jamek Temenggong Daeng Abd Rahman, Benut, Masjid Kg Permatang Palas, Benut, Masjid Tiram Duku, Gelang Patah and Masjid Jamek Senai, Senai.

Also present during the event were Dato’ Sri Che Khalib Mohamad Noh, Group Managing Director of MMC, along with approximately 600 residents.

During the handover ceremony, Datuk Ir. Haji Hasni remarked that he is grateful to MMC Group for their continuous support towards Johor’s sustainable economic development and at the same time improving the quality of life of the local community.

“It is encouraging to see a dynamic, successful corporation that believes in enriching its surrounding communities like MMC Group. We are grateful for their constant support

To date, UTM has received a total of RM3 million in contribution), essential hospital equipment contribution to Hospital Sultanah Aminah, Johor Bahru, Back to School Programme for 380 students from poverty stricken family around Johor as well as seagrass rehabilitation programme in Tanjung Adang, Gelang Patah.”

“In continuation to our initiatives, we are also extending our support to 450 Asnaf in preparation for this upcoming Aidilfitri with contributions of essential items and vouchers worth RM157,000. Apart from that, our educational, community development and environment-based programme for the local communities will also progressed as planned.” added Dato’ Sri Che Khalib.

Mohd Kudus Bin Mat, a representative from Masjid Tiram Duku, Gelang Patah commented that the donation means so much to our community because this will further facilitate and ease funeral management duties and can be benefited local residents greatly in the future.

MMC continues to make inroads in the construction industry, securing key civil and infrastructure projects in the country namely Langat Centralised Sewerage Treatment Plant, Langat 2 Water Treatment Plant, civil and infrastructure works for RAPID Pengerang Cogeneration Plant. Additionally, MMC has a 20% effective interest in Borneo Highway PDP Sdn Bhd (BHP) which has been appointed as PDP for the Sabah Pan Borneo Highway Project.

In other businesses, MMC also owns Aliran Ihsan Resources Berhad (a water treatment plant operator) and operates Senai International Airport, Johor Bahru, a major aviation hub and the main air transportation gateway to Iskandar Malaysia. Surrounding the airport is an area covering over 2,718 acres known as Senai Airport City which is being transformed into a major integrated industrial and commercial development.
