GAS MALAYSIA BERHAD ANNOUNCES THE EXTENSION PERIOD OF THE RELIEF MEASURES FOR ITS CUSTOMERS AFFECTED BY COVID-19

SHAH ALAM, 3 February 2021 — As the Government announced follow-through responses to address the severe impact of COVID-19, Gas Malaysia Berhad (“Gas Malaysia”) through its wholly owned subsidiary, Gas Malaysia Energy and Services Sdn. Bhd (“GMES”), announced the extension period of its special relief measures under the Movement Control Order (“MCO”) to selected customers in alleviating their burden due to the pandemic.

This initiative is a continuous effort from the previous COVID-19 relief measures commenced by GMES, aimed to provide relief to the Government Hospitals, selected Government Quarters and Public Housing consuming natural gas. The provision of the relief measures is focused on the Government Hospitals and the residential customers targeting the B40 and lower M40 income groups. The waiver of the natural gas charge is for the usage from January to March 2021. The gas bill issued to these customers will be given 100% discount during this period.

To further cushion the impact of COVID-19 on our valued customers, Gas Malaysia’s Group Chief Executive Officer, Encik Ahmad Hashimi Abdul Manap said, “As an essential services provider, we play a critical role in facilitating relief measures and assisting those whose livelihoods are affected. These measures are extended for three more months to help ease the monthly gas charges and provide better flexibility for our customers in navigating this trying period.”

Gas Malaysia Berhad, a member of MMC Corporation Berhad, was established on 16 May 1992 to sell, market and distribute natural gas as well as to construct, operate and maintain the Natural Gas Distribution System (“NGDS”) within Peninsular Malaysia. Gas Malaysia is licensed under the Gas Supply Act, 1993 (“GSA”) by the Suruhanjaya Tenaga (“ST”), with the approval of the Minister, to supply and sell reticulated natural gas in Peninsular Malaysia. On 15 December 2000, Gas Malaysia was granted the licence to supply and sell reticulated Liquefied Petroleum Gas (“LPG”). This licence further expands the Gas Malaysia’s business in the supply of reticulated LPG to commercial and residential sectors within Peninsular Malaysia. Gas Malaysia currently operates and maintains over 2,400 kilometres of Natural Gas Distribution System network across Peninsular Malaysia, supplying natural gas and LPG to over 900 industrial customers, approximately 2,300 commercial customers and over 34,000 residential customers.

Currently, MMC is the main turnkey contractor for 52.2 kilometres KVMRT Putrajaya Line (previously known as Sungai Buloh-Serdang-Putrajaya Line). MMC has also successfully completed the 329-kilometre Ipoh-Padang Besar Electrified Double Tracking Project as well as the innovative Stormwater Management and Road Tunnel (“SMART”) motorway, the first of its kind, dual-purpose tunnel in the world. MMC is currently in the final stage of completing the Langat Centralised Sewerage Treatment Plant (which will serve 920,000 Population Equivalent) and Langat 2 Water Treatment Plant (which will supply 1,130 Million Litres of treated water Per Day).
