Tanjung Bruas Port Sdn Bhd ("Tanjung Bruas Port"), a member of MMC Group, is strategically located along with one of the world's busiest trade routes at the centre and narrowest point of the Straits of Malacca.

The port was constructed in late 1970 and commenced operations in early 1980 to provide port facilities and services to the local business communities and to handle the exportation of hinterland goods as well as the importation of raw materials. Situated within a largely developed hinterland drawn from Melaka, Negeri Sembilan and Northern Johor, the port is surrounded by more than 500 companies operating within Melaka's Industrial Parks featuring electrical and electronic companies, fabricated metal product plants, food and furniture manufacturers.

This enables the Port to be developed as a significant gateway to handle both Containers and Conventional cargoes, serving the growing industries in Melaka and the Central Region of Peninsular Malaysia as well as its neighbouring countries. The port is approximately 156KM by road from Kuala Lumpur, the Federal capital and 90KM from the Kuala Lumpur International Airport. Easy accessibility from the East-West Main Trade Lane.

The Port's strategic location also provides an opportunity to tap into marine services such as ship husbandry, ship supplies, bunkering services and ship-to-ship transfers. As the main Gateway Port to Melaka and Riau Province Out-Port Cargo, the services and facilities within TBP covers General Cargo, Dry Bulk, Break Bulk, Liquid Bulk, Container Handling services and Roll-On Roll-Off (RORO) with Dumai Port.
